LABOUR'S TAX ON JOBS WILL KILL THE RECOVERY

The re-election of Gordon Brown's government - with more debt, waste and taxes - will bring us a new recession.

For the last 13 years working people have seen their taxes go up and up and their money wasted. Labour politicians admit there is at least £11 billion of waste, but they want to wait a year before dealing with it. Instead of cutting waste, Gordon Brown is increasing the national insurance tax.

We will cut Labour waste to stop this tax on jobs. Anyone earning between £7,100 and £45,400 will gain by up to £150 a year with the Conservatives. 7 out of 10 working people will be better off under our plans than under Labour – and nobody will be worse off. Experts predict thousands of jobs will be saved.

HOW TOGETHER WE KWASHED IT!

When the Government's crazy health review threatened vital services at Worthing & Southlands Tim leaped into action and formed the Keep Worthing & Southlands Hospitals (KWASH) campaign.

He organised the 8,000 strong promenade rally, spoke at dozens of meetings, raised the issue in Parliament and presented the 129,000 signature petition to the PCT. Tim brought David Cameron down to Worthing to meet hospital staff and give his support. The public response was magnificent. Thousands of people came and did their bit. People power triumphed, the

plans were dropped and a new stronger joint hospital trust formed with Chichester Hospital as Tim had suggested initially. This only happened after a lot of money was wasted on the unnecessary review and many pensioners in particular had been unduly frightened. This was the biggest issue to hit Sussex for years, so when other candidates come knocking ask how they helped the KWASH campaign. Under Conservative health proposals increasing NHS spending, more power will be given to local clinicians to make decisions for local communities on health grounds not by distant faceless bureaucrats.
